Val d'Isere, France – Val d'Isere is located in the Savoie Region of the majestic French Alps, and it is one of Europe's largest and most famous ski resorts. Dare to join a limited number of select people and ski in the tracks made famous by World and Olympic Champion, Jean Claude Killy. This vast area, known as the **Espace Killy**, offers enough challenge to make the region the favorite of accomplished skiers, yet there are plenty of wide-open, rolling slopes for the cruisers who simply want to have a good time without too much challenge. It is literally possible to ski day after day without taking the same run for a second time. Easy-to-intermediate skiing can be found high on the **Solaise** and **Bellevarde** complex, but the long, tough route back down to **Le Laisinant** is for experts only. Enjoy the runs from Val d'Isere to Tignes and return for many hours and miles of skiing in a magnificent setting. This portion of the French Alps is sure to please and impress even the most discerning ski traveler. Ooh, La, La!

Our Hotel: The *****Hotel Altitude** is a ski-in/ski-out family run chalet style hotel. It is located near the Face de Bellevarde ski slope and is known for its warm and home-like atmosphere. Sitting at the foot of the Olympic Gondola, the hotel is just a short 300 meter walk from the village centre. Guests can enjoy traditional Savoyard cuisine in the hotel restaurant and relax with an evening drink by the fireplace in the lounge. There is also a large south-facing terrace for those sunny afternoons. The rooms are adorned with beautiful woodwork and are comfortably spacious. All have a TV, full bath and a balcony with lounge chairs and mountain views. There is free Wi-Fi in all of the public areas of the hotel. **PLEASE NOTE: Ski Passes are not included in the overall trip price, but they will be available to pre-purchase at a discount.**

Copenhagen - After a full week on the snow, we fly to the Danish port city of Copenhagen, a city that is the coolest kid on the Nordic block and consistently rated as "the happiest city in the world". Ask a dozen locals why, and they will probably all zone in on **HYGGE**, which means coziness but encompasses far more. It is this cozy laidback contentment that helps give the Danish capital the X factor. The backdrop to all of this is pretty cool as well. The cobbled, bike friendly, pedestrian friendly streets are an enticing concoction of sherbet-hued houses, craft studios, fun shops and candlelit cafés. Add to this its compact size, and Copenhagen is probably Europe's most seamless urban experience. Copenhagen is also a design capital with that Danish flair. The food, fashion, cocktail and beer scene are hip and chic. However, history and tradition prevail in the wonderful castles, parks and museums that flank the canals running through the city. Your trip leaders have visited Copenhagen twice, one of those in the winter when the spirit of **Hygge** really prevails and makes Copenhagen so special. We love this city and are excited to share it with you.

Our hotel: **Square Hotel Copenhagen** is centrally located, a very short walk from the Central Station and right across the street from the Tourist Office and the Hop-On, Hop-Off bus stop. The main pedestrian-only shopping, dining and café district, **Stroget**, pronounced "Stroll", is mere steps away, too. All that Copenhagen has to offer will be at your doorstep or a short walk or easy ride away via the wonderful public transportation system.

Our Extension includes: a ½ day introductory city tour and lodging at the VERY centrally located 4**** **Square Hotel** (dbl occupancy) with a full European Buffet Breakfast daily.
