Your ski pass will allow you to ski St. Anton, Lech, Zurs, St. Jakob, Stuben, St. Christoph and everywhere in-between! The brand new Flexenbahn opening in 2016/2017 will provide the final link to connect all of the villages in the vast Arlberg Region via lifts and slopes! Quintessential alpine charm and among the most



advanced ski infrastructure in Europe make St. Anton a perfect vacation destination. Add a reputation for some VERY lively après ski and nightlife and that traditional Tyrolean charm to the mix and incredible memories will be made!
