Maurice River Bluffs Hike



We will hike the 5.3-mile loop trail near Millville, New Jersey. Generally considered an easy route. This is a very popular area for birding, fishing, and hiking, and biking. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.

The trail system features a 35-foot-long bridge, steps and rails throughout the steeper parts that make the trails accessible to all levels of hikers, multiple benches and picnic tables, and a bird blind overlooking the river. Named for its majestic rounded cliffs overlooking the 35.4-mile "Wild and Scenic" Maurice River, this 500-acre preserve provides crucial stopover habitat for migrating and breeding birds, including songbirds, waterfowl and raptors like nesting osprey and bald eagles. We will see some marshes where wild rice is growing.

After the hike we will visit the Arts District of Millville and eat in one of the local eateries.
