

Moonlight Canoe/Kayak Outing

Paddle Union Lake with the SJSC!

Come join us for a leisurely moonlight paddle on Union Lake. Located in the southeast corner of Cumberland County on the western outskirts of Millville, Union Lake was created by the damming of the Maurice and Mill Rivers. This oblong lake covers 898 acres and is 4.0 miles long and 1.2 miles at its widest point. Minimum for the trip: 12' kayak, pfd, rear deck light (can be a flashlight or 360' light) front deck light (can be a flashlight attached to the kayak or headlamp) spray skirt recommended.

DIRECTIONS: DIRECTIONS: From north Take Rt 55 South to Rt 552(W.Sherman Ave) towards Bridgeton. Turn left onto Carmel Rd, CR 608, go 3-4 miles look for sign on left. Or Turn Left out of Peek Preserve onto Route 47 North. After 1.5 miles, turn Left onto Route 49/Main St. at the gas station. Continue on Route 49 for 1.3 miles, and then turn Right onto CR 608, Carmel Rd. Follow for 0.7 miles and turn Right at the sign for the Union Lake Wildlife Management Area. Map
