2023-24 Ski Season Trip Sign Ups

It is important to understand the process of how to sign up for a SJSK trip, as trips are expected to fill up quickly. Here's **very important** information you need to know about the trip openings and registration:

- 1. Membership** – you **MUST** be a SJSK member **to be eligible to SIGN UP** for any trip. Becoming a member means completing the Membership Application found at sjskiclub.com membership page, paying your \$25 membership fee **AND** signing and returning the Hold Harmless Agreement and Liability Release, Indemnity Agreement, and Policies and Procedures, which will be emailed to you separately. This could take a day or more, so please be patient.
 - The \$25 membership dues payment made by credit card is not subject to credit card fees.
 - Membership registration for the 2023-24 season is open and the membership year runs from May 1 through April 30.
 - To ensure you are able to sign up for trips, do **NOT** wait until the Opening Night meeting to become a member. We suggest you renew your membership by June 8 to simplify trip registration. The registration process is lengthy and may delay your ability to register for the trip of your choice.
- 2. Trip registrations opens online at sjskiclub.com on Tuesday, June 13 at 6:00 PM for all members.**
 - This is one day before the Opening Night meeting on June 14.
 - Once you have registered for a trip in our on-line registration system, Wild Apricot, your reservation is held, but **not confirmed, until payment is received by the trip leader before the close of business at the Opening Night meeting.**
 - If you register for a trip, but the trip has become filled, you will have the option to join a wait list for that trip, with a \$50 deposit, which will be applied to your trip if the spot later becomes available. The deposit is refunded only if a spot does not become available. After the close of business at the Opening Night meeting, waitlisted members will be moved up in the order of their trip registration in Wild Apricot. Trip registration order is maintained impartially by Wild Apricot.
 - Trips may be paid for by cash, check or credit card.
- 3. Paying for trips using a major credit card online.**
 - Using a credit card to make payment for a trip requires **payment of the entire balance** that exists at that time. Example 1: When you first sign up for a trip, if you want to pay by credit card you must pay the entire price of the trip at that time. Example 2: If you paid your first installment for a trip by check, and then you want to pay by credit card, you must pay off the entire remaining balance at that time.
 - Our online system will **NOT** accommodate multiple credit payments for a trip.
 - You will incur a **3.1% processing fee** on all **trip** payments made by credit card.
- 4. Paying by cash or check**
 - You may pay in installments or in full.
 - If you register online for a trip on June 13 (the day before the Opening Night meeting), in order to confirm your place on the trip, **the trip leader must receive no less than the first installment payment amount no later than 9:00 PM on Wednesday June 14.** All trip leaders will be available to receive payments at the Opening Night meeting at Ramblewood Country Club Grand Ballroom, 200 Country Club Pkwy., Mt Laurel, NJ 08054 beginning at 6:30 PM.
 - Additional installments are due to the trip leader by the dates posted in the trip flyer and can be made in person or by mail.

Trip registrations can only be made using Wild Apricot We strongly recommend that members and their chosen roommate register for trips the day before the Opening Night meeting for efficiency and to allow you to get into the sign-up queue as soon as possible. Trip leaders will be available to assist with online registrations at the Opening Night meeting for those needing assistance.
